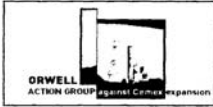

Orwell Action Group Update

Although Cemex have suspended their Planning Application, OAG is continuing to monitor the situation and will keep residents informed of any further developments.

The Waste and Minerals consultation period has now ended - thank you to everyone who took the time to respond. The results will be fed into the County Council's 'Preferred Options Plan' for Minerals and

Waste (to be published in the summer) followed by a further period of formal consultation.

The next Barrington Liaison Group meeting is on Thursday 27th April when Cemex will report on their plans for the future of the cement works.

The Liason Group will also be monitoring the trial use of Climafuel (a fuel derived from packaging waste).
